

Ag Day Exhibits

Sand Saucer

- No sand showing
- Must be a saucer or similar sized plate
- Symmetrical design
- Evidence of pattern
- Completed by the student only



Vaseline Saucer

- Saucer or similar sized plate
- Covered in Vaseline with flowers/patterns arranged in a symmetrical pattern
- No saucer showing
- Petals/ flowers firmly attached to plate by Vaseline
- Completed by the student



Book Themed Miniature Garden

- The title of the book is displayed
- There is a short description of how the scene fits with the book
- The scene is visually pleasing and interesting to look at
- The parts may be prepared at home, but must be assembled by the child at school



Photograph

- The photo is taken by the child and a parent has signed to say that this is so
- The photo must be brought to school on the Thursday before Ag day to give time for judging



Unusual Floral Container

- Container must be able to hold water
- Container must be stable
- Majority of plants/flowers must be living, but may be supplemented with some artificial material
- Must be assembled at school



Floral Arrangements

- Must be assembled by the student at school
- Containers must be stable
- Arrangements show balance and/or style
- Flowers are in good condition



Recycled Critters

Must be assembled by the student at school
Adults may assist only with cutting difficult items. Cutting and assembling is at the student's direction

- Critter must stay intact and have all its 'bits' secure
- Critter must be made from recycled materials and preferably held together with wire, rubber bands or screws. Hot glue is ok for paper based products.
